Driver's education is a three phase program at Copper Hills. They are as follows:

Phase # 1 Classroom and Bookwork

Classroom instructors: Mike Wright, Eric Gunderson

-Student's must have **30 hours** of classroom instruction, **state law**

(You can miss one class and still meet state requirements)

-Students must attend a **zero fatality presentation on April 14th at 7:00 pm in the auditorium, Jordan school District guideline**

-Students must receive an **80%** on final classroom grade **State law**

-Students are required to obtain permit by end of the quarter

-State final will be given on Day # 8 (this final will also count as state permit test)

-must pass final with 80 %

-Student need to pay 95.00 class fee to main office or on skyward and bring receipt to class

-Disclosure due on Day #8

Phase # 2 Range Driving

-Each student will sign up today for 3 ranges **State Law**

-Each range is two hours long total 6 hours on range **State Law**

-No permit needed for range driving

-Range times and dates are on the signup sheets

-Must do observation before first range District Guideline?

Phase # 3 Road Drives

- Each student must do 3 road drives **State Law**
- Instructor will be assigned on Day # 3
- You are responsible to schedule your road times
- You must have a **permit** to schedule and do your drives **State Law**
